

**MINUTES OF THE  
BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING  
VILLAGE OF EAST WILLISTON  
January 12, 2026**

A business meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of East Williston was held on Monday, January 12, 2026, at 7:00 pm at the Village Hall, 2 Prospect Street, East Williston, New York. The Board members present were Deputy Mayor Anthony Gallo, and Trustees Rafaella Dunne, Rushi Vaidya, and James Iannone. Also in attendance were Village Counsel Steven Leventhal, Esq., Treasurer Scott Cunningham, and Village Clerk Joanna Palumbo. Mayor Bonnie Parente was absent.

No motions were made, and no actions were taken.

General topics discussed included: Upcoming centennial events.

The Business meeting was then followed by the Regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of East Williston at 7:30 pm. Deputy Mayor Anthony Gallo, and Trustees Rafaella Dunne, Rushi Vaidya, and James Iannone. Also in attendance were Village Counsel Steven Leventhal, Esq., Treasurer Scott Cunningham, and Village Clerk Joanna Palumbo. Mayor Parente arrived at 7:42pm.

Deputy Mayor Gallo verified a quorum of the Board and led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

### **MOTIONS**

A motion that the minutes from the December 8, 2025 Board of Trustee meeting and the December 29, 2025 Board of Trustee business meeting be approved was made by Trustee Vaidya and seconded by Trustee Dunne. **The motion was passed unanimously.**

A motion that the Board of Trustees approve the Check Register by Check Date report dated January 12, 2026 was made by Trustee Vaidya and seconded by Trustee Dunne. **The motion was passed unanimously.**

### **REPORTS**

#### **DEPUTY MAYOR GALLO**

Deputy Mayor Gallo reported that the Fire Department responded to 6 calls in December, 8 general calls and 1 medical call. He also reported that the East Williston Little League registration is open until this Friday for all levels, baseball & softball.

#### **TRUSTEE DUNNE**

Trustee Dunne reported that It's a slow time for regular recreation programming, but the Centennial committee has organized many events to celebrate this village's Centennial, first of which is this Wednesday January 14th at 7:00 PM at the Community Church. The Cat's Meow and the engravable brinks marking the centennial can be purchased through the village office.

**TRUSTEE IANNONE**

Trustee Iannone reported that the Village Court disposed of 204 parking violations, 1 moving violation, and 3 Village ordinances and collected \$1,208.00 in fines. He also invited all to the next senior's luncheon which will be held on Thursday January 15 lunch and chair yoga are scheduled.

**TRUSTEE VAIDYA**

Trustee Vaidya reported that structures on the Village's right-of-way are a hazard to pedestrians and motorists and residents should move them back onto their own property or remove them.

**VILLAGE CLERK PALUMBO**

Clerk Palumbo presented the Nassau County Police Department crime report for East Williston for the month of December 2025, which included 2 auto accidents & 8 aided cases. She also reported that for the months of October, November & December there was a total of 25 building permits and 12 plumbing permits issued.

A motion to close the meeting was made at 7:47pm by Trustee Vaidya and seconded by Trustee Dunne. **The motion was passed unanimously.**
